Protocols for attending the Public celebration of Holy Mass from 10th May:

Face coverings must be worn
2 metre distance
sanitising of hands on entry and exit of church.
Church capacity is 50 people.
Cooperation with the stewards would be appreciated.
Wedding and Funeral capacity is set at 50 people.

RAPHOE DIOCESAN SOCIETY: We are encouraged to have our deceased relatives enrolled in the Society and we are encouraged to become living members. Any person wishing to become a member of the R.D.S. may apply to any of the Diocesan Clergy. (Membership fee is €15 per person) An annual Diocesan Mass will be offered for the Raphoe Diocesan Society. First Communion and Confirmation Bishop McGuckian, SJ, acting on public health advice, has advised that First Communion and Confirmation should not proceed at this time. It is not to do with the ceremonies themselves but is in relation to concerns about the social gatherings which might occur afterwards. The Bishop urges parents, teachers and clergy to continue to ensure that all the necessary catechetical preparations are being made for the Sacraments. And he regrets that this decision will cause disappointment and frustration for children, parents, schools and parishes. As Government health advice and guidelines change, the parish will have a clearer sense of when these Liturgies may be rescheduled.
